Are you interested in studying the Bible at a deeper level for 10 weeks?

The Preliminary Theological Certificate (PTC), run by Moore Theological College is an affordable course that will help you grow in your knowledge of Gods Word. It aims to give students a solid introduction to the biblical, theological and historical foundations of the Christian faith.

Throughout third term, we will be studying **Ephesians** which systematically works through Paul's letter to the Ephesians, showing that God's intention is to unify all things in Christ. While we wait for this intention to be completely fulfilled, God has already provided a living demonstration of this unity in the church, in which the fundamental distinction between Jew and Gentile has now been overcome. The subject unpacks the implications of this new unity for individuals, the church and the whole creation.

PTC runs for 10 weeks. There is also great benefit in studying in groups, so we will meet on Thursday nights to discuss the notes and to encourage each other. Each week, you'll be required to read 10-15 pages of notes before meeting with our group to discuss them. There are a number of joys of being in a PTC group, such as learning together, experiencing God at work in our lives, growing in our understanding of the message of the Bible, and increasing our confidence to read the Bible ourselves.

Since PTC is the external studies arm of Moore Theological College, there is an enrolment fee (\$50).

You will then be given access to the online learning environment where you will find the course notes, quizzes and extra reading material.
